order of the Day to the appointment of a Governor for this Commonwealth and the Members having prepared their Tickets and put the same into the Ballot box M. Wythe M. Curle M. Dandridge and M. Madison were appointed a Committee to examine the same and report upon whom the Majority falls and it appearing from their report that the Numbers stood as follows—

For Patrick Henry Junr. Esq<sup>r</sup> ——60

Thomas Nelson Esq<sup>r</sup>——45

John Page Esq<sup>r</sup>———1

Resolved therefore that the said Patrick Henry Esq<sup>r</sup>: be Governor of this Commonwealth to continue in that office until the End of the succeeding Session of Assembly after the last of March next and that M.<sup>r</sup> Mason M.<sup>r</sup> Henry Lee M<sup>r</sup>. Digges M.<sup>r</sup> Blair and M.<sup>r</sup> Dandridge be a Committee to wait upon him and notify [him of] such appointment—

Resolved that the sum of sixteen hundred – Pounds per Annum be the Salary of the Privy Council to be divided among the Members in proportion
