Wherous it is represented to be the clesive of the people inhabiting the Counties hereinagter mentioned, to be separated from this Commonwealth, and to be exected into a Separate and passer\_ State, and admitted into the Union of States, and become a member of the Govern ment of the United States; The People of Virginia, by their delegates as -Sembled in Convention at theelings do ordain, that a new State, to be called the State of Nau awha, be formed and exected out of the territory included within the following des-Cribed boundary; be giving on the Jug Forto of Sandy River, on the Neutricky line where the Counties of Buchunan and Logan join the Same; and running thence, with the dividing lines of Said Counties and the Clividing line of the Counties of Myoning and M. Dowell to the Mercer County line; and with the dividing line of the Counties of Mercer and Myoming to the Raleigh, Country line; comment thence, with the dividing line of the Courties of Kaleigh and Mercer, Monroe and Raleigh, Greenbrier and Ruleigh, Fayetto and Greenbrier, Nicholas and Green - brier, Webster, Greenbrier and Posahintas, Randolph and Pocahintus, Randolph and Pendleton, to the South west Come of Houdy County; thence, with the divi-- ding line of the Counties of Harry and

33 Tucker, to the Fairfay Stone; thence with the line dividing the States of Mary land and Virginia, the Pennsylvania line; thence, with the line Clividing the States of Pennsylvania and Virginia the Ohio river; thence, down Said river and including the Same, to the dividing line between Verginia and Neutucky, and with the Said the beginning; including within the bounda\_ ries of the proposed new state the Counties young, Raleigh, Fayette, Nicholas, M dolph, Tucker, Preston, Mooningalia, Marion, Jay Lor, Barbour, Upshur, Harrison, Lewis, to lay, Nanawha, Boone, Wayne, Cabell, e Mason, Jackson, Roane, Calhoun, Wirt & Ritchie, Wood, Pleasants, Tyler, Doddidge, 1 Marshall, Ohis, Brooke and Hancock,
