


FINDING SLAVE NAMES IN THE CHANCERY RECORDS INDEX

Slave names found in the Chancery Records Index have been assigned the tilde symbol (~). To search for slave names found in the Chancery Records Index, select the desired locality (hold the CTRL key to select multiple localities) and enter a tilde symbol (~) in the Last Name field for Plaintiff or Defendant or enter it in the Surname field. Select "INCLUDES" as the filter. See example below:




Note: Entering search terms in the Surname(s) field queries name fields for Plaintiff(s) and Defendant(s), as well as other parties mentioned in the suit.

Click the Search button. A list of chancery suits containing slave names will appear. A slave name can appear in the name of the suit or in the details of the suit.
