To the clerk of the Hustings Court of said City:

I, Jno. F. Regnault, Recorder Mayor of the said City, do hereby certify, that I have this day admitted Christopher Jones (Colored) to bail for his appearance before the Hustings Court of said City on the first day of the next May term thereof, to be exammid in the said Court for a felony by him committed in this, that he did on the 23^d day of April 1867, in the said city and State of Virginia, feloniously and Maliciously Conspire with a large number of Colored persons, to wit to the number of one Hundred or more, to incite the Colored population of the said City and State to make insurrection by acts of violence and war against the white population of the said City and State and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia. Given under my hand, this 24th day April 1867
